Our team had a truly interesting and insightful conversation with Karen and we would like to share it with you.

### What motivated you to pursue education at Macquarie Community College?

I needed to maintain and upgrade the level of my computer skills. I wanted to align with the rapid and increasing changes in technology and business requirements.

The course subjects are aligned with community and current business demands. The structure and content are very practical.

The locations of each college campus, Epping and Chatswood, are within walking distance of public transport.

### Can you share a memorable moment or experience from your time at MCC?

This is a challenging question, as there have been many memorable moments in the past, and I know there will be more during my time at MCC.

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# Top 5 Tips to Improve Your English

## MCC Teachers Top 5 Tips to Improve Your English Outside the Classroom.

Learning any language always goes beyond classroom time. You can improve faster by practising language skills in your daily life.

### 1. Speak English Every Day

Describe your day, talk about your plans, or name what you see around you.

**Prepare a few phrases or sentences in advance if it helps.** This builds confidence and fluency.

**Our student Muhammad shared:**

**"I felt very unconfident. I could understand people speaking English at shops and at college. I felt ashamed to speak because of my accent and mistakes.**

**What helped me was thinking ahead and preparing phrases in advance. Then I started speaking, even with mistakes. It became easier over time. People supported me and never laughed."**

### 2. Listen to English Media

Watch English videos, listen to podcasts, or music every day. Choose content you enjoy and listen actively.

**Use subtitles to support understanding and improve reading skills.** This helps you hear real-life English.

### 3. Read English Content

Read news, books, or short articles every day. Reading builds vocabulary and improves understanding. It also helps you see how English works in real situations.

Dina, an Intermediate English student, shared:

**"I go to Epping Library with my daughter almost every day. There are so many books. I can read and my daughter has fun too."**

### 4. Find a "Chat Partner"

Find language exchange partner online or in your community. Practise speaking with other learners or native speakers. Regular conversations build confidence and real-world skills.

**At MCC, teachers encourage small talk before and after classes.** We also encourage students to practise outside class. A chat partner can be a classmate, neighbour, or volunteer.

### 5. Use Learning Apps and Tools

Use free apps to practise grammar, vocabulary, and speaking. Consistent short sessions help you review and improve fast.

Apps like Duolingo and others support daily practice and confidence building.

# Foreign Languages



## Finding your level

### Foreign Languages

We have simplified the structure of our foreign language courses. This has been done based on feedback from tutors and students and with the aim of offering a more regular and consistent offering across each language and location. The previously offered 10 levels have been restricted to 4 levels – Introduction, Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced.

The introduction courses are designed as a one course only starting point for new students, but the other levels allow for students to continue until they reach the required competency to progress. The time to develop this competency will vary between students but as a guide 2 to 4 terms is often required. Continuing students should discuss with the tutor when they are ready to progress to the next level and new students with a prior background in the

language should contact the college to be assessed and placed into the correct class.

### Introduction (previously Level 1)

This level is for students with little or no experience in the language. Classes will be conducted in English and students will learn greetings, basic vocabulary and some simple aspects of conversation. These courses will suit students starting out in the study of the language or just looking for some basics of the language for travel, work or social situations.

### Beginners (previously Levels 2 and 3)

This level will provide the next step for students that have completed the Introduction course or have a basic knowledge of the language from previous study, travel or other exposure. Classes will be conducted in English but some basic conversations

in the chosen language will be introduced.

### Intermediate (previously Levels 4 and 5)

Students should have the capacity to conduct a simple conversation using basic language. This may have been obtained through the completion of the Beginners level or other study. Classes will increasingly be delivered in the language being learnt and focus will be on more complex vocabulary, grammar, reading and writing.

### Advanced (previously Level 6 and above)

Courses at this level are largely conducted in the chosen language. Students should be capable of holding a simple conversation or follow a conversation between fluent speakers. A basic understanding of reading, writing and grammar will be further developed at this level.
