Student Success Stories

Finding Purpose in Aged Care: Elizabeth's Journey at MCC

After 17 years in administration, Elizabeth felt something was missing. Her job was stable, but her heart wanted more. Elizabeth felt she could give back more and make someone's life better.

Some of her friends were working in aged care. They spoke about connection, purpose and community. Their stories stayed with her.

” *“It took me a while to think about it,” Elizabeth admits. Changing careers is never a small decision.”*

A Personal Connection to Aged Care

For Elizabeth, aged care is deeply personal. Her father passed away when she was very young. Growing up without a parent shaped her perspective.

“I always felt a connection to elderly people,” she shares. “I just want to be around them.”

On her first day at MCC, she felt nervous. Walking into a new classroom can be overwhelming.

Then she met her trainer, Jas Khanooja.

“He had the most beautiful smile,” she recalls. “He was funny and made us laugh straight away.”

The nerves disappeared quickly. The classroom felt safe, warm and welcoming.

“I think Jas has a special way of building trust,” she says.

Elizabeth formed friendships with classmates who share similar values.

“We are all doing this for the right reasons,” she explains.

Online Zoom classes feel connected and interactive.

“It's not like studying alone,” she says “When we meet for practical days, we feel like old friends.”

The Pride of Making a Difference

Elizabeth has now worked in aged care for two years. She feels proud when she talks about her job.

“In admin, I never felt proud to say what I did,” she reflects. “Now I proudly say I work in aged care.”

What she values most is dignity. Many clients struggle with losing independence.

They still want control over their lives.

“I learned how important respect really is,” she explains.

Her clients share incredible life stories. They speak about resilience, hardship and love.

“They have so much wisdom to give us,” she says.



Personal care once worried her. She thought she might not cope with that responsibility.

Now it is her favourite part of the role.

“It's very personal,” she explains. “I help someone shower or get dressed.”

“I help them feel comfortable and confident again.”

You walk away with gratitude. You walk away feeling proud to support older Australians.

Balancing Study, Family and Dreams

Elizabeth balances study, work and family life. She sometimes wonders how women manage everything. Yet she continues to prove it is possible.

Her partner and sister are her biggest supporters.

“They think it's amazing,” she smiles.

She loves sharing stories from her course with her children. It teaches them about ageing and empathy.

“They learn older people are not just old,” she says. “They have meaningful lives and experiences.”

When she completes her Certificate III, Elizabeth may continue studying. A Diploma is something she is considering. For now, she is focused on finishing strong.

Advice for Future Aged Care Students

Elizabeth's advice is simple and honest.

“You will know quickly if it's right for you,” she says.

She suggests starting with social support work. It helps you discover if you connect with older people.

“If you feel that connection, everything else comes naturally.”

She also reassures future students about employment opportunities.

“There are so many jobs in aged care,” she explains. “The sector really needs the right people.”

Balancing Study and Work: Practical Tips for Adult Learners

Adult learners often juggle work, family, and study at the same time. This can feel overwhelming. But with a clear plan, good habits, and the right support, you can manage your responsibilities and reach your goals.

Many MCC students face the same challenge — and find ways to make it work. We gathered the practical tips from our students and tutors to share with you.

Set Clear Goals

Define what you want to achieve in your study and work life. Ask yourself:

- What skills do I need?
- What deadlines matter most?

Setting clear goals helps you stay focused when life gets busy.

Our Business course student Michel shared:

“I work full-time, so I needed to be very clear about why I was studying. Once I set my goal, it became easier to stay motivated.”

Make a Weekly Study and Work Schedule

Plan your week in advance. Block out time for:

- Work
- Family
- Study
- Rest

Use a digital calendar or planner app to schedule study sessions at times that work for you. Short, regular study time is better than long sessions you can't maintain.

Karen, a Computer Skills student, shared:

“I plan my week ahead and set aside small blocks of time for study. Even one hour a day makes a big difference.”

Prioritise Tasks

Not all tasks have equal importance. Make a simple list and rank tasks by urgency.

Work on your most important tasks first. Knowing what matters most reduces stress and keeps you productive.

MCC Child Care student Lin explained:

“I focus on one task at a time. When I finish something important, I feel more in control of my schedule.”

Use Technology to Manage Study and Work

Use tools to help manage your study and daily life:

- Calendar apps (like Google Calendar)
- To-do lists (Trello, Notion)
- Reminder apps for deadlines

Technology helps you stay organised and keeps everything in one place.

Our English student Shifa shared:

“I use my phone calendar to remind me about classes and homework. It helps me stay on track.”

Balancing work and study is difficult if you feel tired or stressed.

Make time for:

- Sleep
- Exercise
- Healthy food
- Short breaks

Rest keeps your mind sharp and your energy strong.

A Short Course student shared:

“I realised I needed breaks to stay focused. Even a short walk helps me reset. I started Yoga course and it was the best decision!”

With flexible courses and the right approach, you can build skills and move towards your career goals.

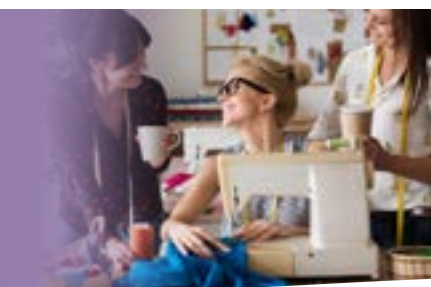

Finding your level

Foreign Languages

We have simplified the structure of our foreign language courses. This has been done based on feedback from tutors and students and with the aim of offering a more regular and consistent offering across each language and location. The previously offered 10 levels have been restricted to 4 levels – Introduction, Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced.

The introduction courses are designed as a one course only starting point for new students, but the other levels allow for students to continue until they reach the required competency to progress. The time to develop this competency will vary between students but as a guide 2 to 4 terms is often required. Continuing students should discuss with the tutor when they are ready to progress to the next level and new students with a prior background in the

language should contact the college to be assessed and placed into the correct class.

Introduction (previously Level 1)

This level is for students with little or no experience in the language. Classes will be conducted in English and students will learn greetings, basic vocabulary and some simple aspects of conversation. These courses will suit students starting out in the study of the language or just looking for some basics of the language for travel, work or social situations.

Beginners (previously Levels 2 and 3)

This level will provide the next step for students that have completed the Introduction course or have a basic knowledge of the language from previous study, travel or other exposure. Classes will be conducted in English but some basic conversations

in the chosen language will be introduced.

Intermediate (previously Levels 4 and 5)

Students should have the capacity to conduct a simple conversation using basic language. This may have been obtained through the completion of the Beginners level or other study. Classes will increasingly be delivered in the language being learnt and focus will be on more complex vocabulary, grammar, reading and writing.

Advanced (previously Level 6 and above)

Courses at this level are largely conducted in the chosen language. Students should be capable of holding a simple conversation or follow a conversation between fluent speakers. A basic understanding of reading, writing and grammar will be further developed at this level.
